Congratulations to the P&C for organising our successful Mother's Day raffle, and thank you to everyone who contributed. It raised \$296 for our Mungallala SS P&C.

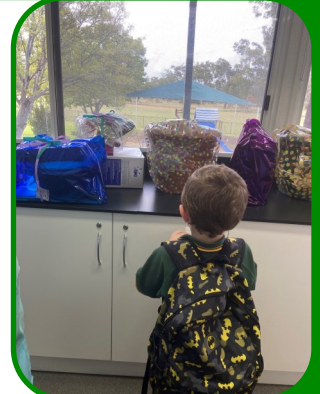
Congratulations to the winners of our raffle; Dixie Burey, Sandy Chambers, Bill Parr, Roslyn Ware and Allan Wehl.

Reading

Miss Wilson has recently attended Professional Development in Roma to assist with the teaching of reading at Mungallala State School. Our first focus area is to develop an enjoyment of reading.

All students have chosen books to read independently and with others during Buddy Reading. We are using a 'synthetic phonics' approach to teach phonics and listening to books and audiobooks to develop our comprehension. We have also subscribed to the eBooks Digital Library, which has given our students access to some of the 85000 books, audio books and magazines on the site. This library can be accessed on laptops or iPads, through the website and application Sora.

All students have loved independent and buddy reading activities, and there have been many fantastic literary discussions about our favourite books during our daily Yarning Circles.
